




Use your thumbprints to make a one-of-a-kind family Christmas card you can share with friends and family.

WHAT YOU DO:


Fold the card in half.

MY FAVOURITE CHRISTMAS MEMORY

GINGERBREAD BAKING!

There's nothing like the delicious smells coming out of the oven on Christmas Day. Gingerbread biscuits were one of my favourite Christmas treats growing up. I loved baking and decorating them with my mum.

WHAT YOU NEED:

INGREDIENTS:

175 grams dark
muscovado sugar
85 grams golden syrup
100 grams butter
350 grams plain flour,
plus extra for dusting!
1 tsp bicarbonate of soda
1 tbsp ground ginger
1 tsp ground cinnamon
1 egg, beaten



WHAT TO DO:

Melt the sugar, golden syrup and butter in a saucepan, then bubble for 1-2 min. Leave to cool about 10 minutes.

Odd the dry ingredients (flour, bicarbonate of soda, spices) into a large bowl. Odd the syrup mixture and egg, and stir everything.

Gently knead dough until smooth. Wrap in cling film and chill for at least 30 minutes.

Remove dough from fridge and leave at Room temperature until softened. Heat oven to 200C/180C and line two baking trays with baking paper.

Roll out dough approx. 5mm thick, then cut out gingerbread shapes with a cutter. Place gingerbread biscuits onto tray and bake for 10-12 minutes.

Transfer biscuits onto a wire rack to cool, then using your chocolate buttons, sweets and icing, decorate your very own delicious gingerbread family!



TOP TIP!

Use as many cookie cutters, or different items as you can to have lots of shapes and sizes for your biscuits!
