"She was like a newborn. But a newborn could eat. We had to tube feed Kira. She had to be fed 22 hours a day with a pump".

Kira loves her time in LauraLynn. She and her family have benefited from weekend stays in our Dublin Hospice, which her mum, Oana, says it is like a 'mini vacation' for her daughter.
